MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Membership classes and subscription rates will be proposed by the Trustees for ratification by voting members at a General Meeting of the Society.

All new membership applications should be made on the appropriate application form and will be subject to approval by the Trustees prior to the application being accepted.

The membership year runs from 1st January to 31st December.

To maintain insurance cover subscriptions need to be paid before the start of the year.

Members not renewing by 28th February with no explanation will be considered to have resigned.

All new members joining after 30th September will not be asked to pay another subscription fee until the end of the following year.

Fees shown below are correct for 2018.

FULL MEMBERSHIP

Full members of the Society are entitled to:-

- vote at appropriate meetings and become Trustees,
- receive all Society communications (by email where possible),
- use Society facilities at any reasonable time,
- hold keys to Society facilities (subject to satisfying Security requirements),
- participate in running the railways (once training has been completed).

The current full subscription rate is £35 per year or £17.50 for new members joining between 1st July and 30th September.

A **Young Persons** rate is available to all those aged between 18 and 25 inclusive at 1st January of the subscription year. The Young Persons rate is half the Full member rate i.e. £17.50 per year.

A **Partners** reduced rate of £5 is available for partners of members.

Members paying Young Person and Partner rates have the same entitlements as Full members.

ASSOCIATE (non-voting) MEMBERSHIP

Associate members are not entitled to vote, become Trustees or hold keys to Society assets.

Two classes of Associate members are currently supported: Junior and Honorary.

Junior members are entitled to:-

- § receive all Society communications (by email where possible),
- § use Society facilities when they are open,
- § participate in running the railways (once training has been completed and subject to some age related restrictions).

The current subscription rate is £5 per year and membership is open to all those who are aged 10 to 17 inclusive at 1st January of the subscription year. Junior memberships must be countersigned by a Full member guardian who will be responsible for them when they are at Society facilities.

Honorary members will be proposed by the Trustees and then subject to approval at a General Meeting of the Society. Honorary members are not expected to pay any subscription fee.

Honorary members are entitled to:-

- receive Society newsletters (by email or post),
- use Society facilities when they are open.
