Locomotive Driving Experience Day At CinderBarrow Miniature Railway

Come and enjoy a day driving a miniature locomotive on our 7 1/4" Gauge railway. You can choose between an electric or steam locomotive. During the afternoon you have the opportunity to take your family for a trip around our quarter of a mile track.



You will learn how to:

- Prepare a loco, oiling up and raising steam
- Identify and manage the controls, knowing how and when to use them
- Understand basic signalling procedures
- Drive under close supervision on our track
- Convey your family around our track if you are deemed competent
- Learn how to "Put the Loco to bed"

Frequently asked questions

- Is there an age limit? *Attendees must be 16 years and over.*
- Do I need any special clothing? *Gloves, a hat, goggles/glasses and overalls are recommended to protect clothes, otherwise old clothes should be worn in case of sparks and grease etc. Also, bring a waterproof coat, in case of rain. Wear a strong pair of shoes, preferably with toe protectors.*
- How many will attend each Driving Day Experience? *A maximum of four people will share your experience.*
- Can I book on behalf of someone else? *Yes (Gift vouchers are available on request).*
- What is included? *All necessary equipment, training and supervision to ensure you have a safe and memorable experience. Light refreshments are provided and a commemorative certificate is issued after the event.*
